Interdisciplinary Young Researchers Seminar on Water Management for Climate Change Adaptation in Japan and an associated excursion to Japan and Korea.

The Young Researchers Seminar in Japan is organized jointly by TU Delft, Seoul National University (Republic of Korea) and University of Tokyo (Japan), and will take place from 7th to 11th September 2009 in Tokyo. It will be held with 2nd Rainwater Harvesting and Management Conference and 8th Urban Drainage Modeling Conference.

The associated excursions in Korea and Japan offer a unique possibility for the young researchers from the Netherlands to learn from good practice examples for sustainable urban water management in the two countries, which are internationally well known for their innovation potential.

In Japan the excursions to the Tokyo Metropolitan Area will include technical tours, which are related to sustainable urban water management.

In Korea the excursion will include joint activities with local universities and the study of projects which are related to water and sustainability issues, such as urban water management systems, parks, new urban developments and contemporary architecture, amongst others e.g. Star City and Cheonggyecheon.

Participants of this excursion will receive 3 ECTS (AR0102 Research & Design for Sustainable Development). The combination with additional free choice courses is possible.
